



Growing Dual Language Programs




Almost every state has at least some dual language programs.

Higher language skills are linked to growth in the **hippocampus** and areas of the cerebral **cortex** – associated with memory, thought and action.



A 2012 Swedish MRI study show that **learning a language improves cortical thickness** – a layered mass of neurons largely responsible for:

Dual Language brings cognitive Benefits to English Learners



"Children need to reach a cognitive threshold in their first language in order to avoid negative cognitive effects. If your children can continue to develop their first language until at least age 12, their cognitive development will be adequately supported, and they will build on this development throughout life."



Dual Language Supports the Academic Achievement of English Learners

Compared to ELs in ESL-only programs, ELs in DL programs....

- score significantly higher on state tests as well as norm-referenced tests;
- master much more of the curriculum, academically and linguistically;
- master English better (even though only half or less of thei instruction is in English).

Bilingualism expands professional opportunities



Dual Language supports the development of a positive sense of identity

- » High levels of satisfaction and enjoyment
- » Stronger cultural identity and high self-esteem
- » Significantly fewer behavioral referrals
- » More favorable attitudes toward being bilingual and toward students who are different from themselves


